(No Gift Policy)

Khaochakan Police Station is committed to developing operations to be transparent, adhering to the public interest more than personal interest, without conflicts of interest, in line with the national reform plan on prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct (revised edition), which aims for agencies to operate transparently and without benefits. All government officials do not accept gifts or presents of any kind from performing duties (No Gift Policy).

Therefore, we hereby announce the intention of the Superintendent of Khaochakan Police Station and all police officers not to accept gifts or presents of any kind from performing duties (No Gift Policy), jointly creating an organizational culture and honest values in performing duties, not accepting patronage systems, avoiding actions that may affect discretion or decision-making in performing duties, leading to discrimination, preventing unfair performance of duties and not creating conflicts of interest, and building public confidence in performing duties with good governance.
